We have been working with the Infrastructure Committee, Workplace Fairness and their vendor Endurtech ™ over the last several months to develop the new design for the website and improved listserve.

Access to the new site and listserv will be limited to those who have paid a \$25 annual access fee. We will announce the date when this will go into effect.
