justice activist, Gary worked with the UFW on a grape boycott in Pittsburg before moving to Bakersfield, California to work with Cesar Chavez. While in California, he learned how to print.

After moving to New York City, he and his wife, Miriam Melendez, began Grass Roots Press. They moved the business to Raleigh in 1988.
