The Committee will award a cash prize of \$500 along with up to \$400 in travel expenses to attend the awards ceremony at LAWCHA's next general meeting in New Orleans at the Organization of American Historians Conference on American History (April 2024).

1. A dissertation prospectus of up to 2,000 words discussing the project and the significance of your work to the field, your methodology, and the sources to be consulted.
